

Clearance of Containers Removed outside the Port Territory by Rail Transport



Stage 1. Issuing Loading Permits

Forwarder

Enters the work order in PCIS:

- From its working place;
- Submits a set of paper documents with an authorised person, i.e. worker of SE “ASPU” who enters the Information in PCIS.



Customs officer

Processes the work order by PCIS thereby giving permit to load the stuffed containers onto the transport facility.



Stage 2. Loading on Rail Transport

Stevedore company (container terminal)

Loads containers onto the transport facility.

Given technical feasibility, it uses the data of the PCIS electronic work order and makes a note of loading the container onto the flat-car.



Stage 3. Issuing Permit to Leave the Checkpoint Territory

Step 1. Customs Officer

Upon completion of customs clearance makes a note in PCIS as to the permit for the loaded container leaving the territory of the checkpoint.

Makes a corresponding note concerning the permit to leave in the railroad waybill.



Stage 3. Issuing Permit to Leave the Checkpoint Territory

Step 2. Officer of Border Unit

Verifies the documents filed for clearance and availability of the customs Officer's permit note in PCIS.

Given no remarks, makes the note permitting the stuffed containers to leave the territory of the checkpoint.

Makes corresponding notes in the Railroad Waybill.



Stage 3. Issuing Permit to Leave the Checkpoint Territory

Step 3. Port Security Officer

Verifies the filed documents and availability in PCIS and Railroad Waybill the permit notes of:

- **Customs**
- **Border Unit.**

Given no remarks, makes the note permitting the stuffed containers to leave the territory of the checkpoint.

Makes a corresponding note in the Railroad Waybill.



Stage 3. Issuing Permit to Leave the Checkpoint Territory

Step 4. Railway Station Officer

Verifies the filed documents and availability of customs' note in the Railroad Waybill.

Given no remarks, effects the departure of the railway platform with containers from the territory of the checkpoint
